# 2024-2025 Rules and Policies Level 8

#### Number of Meets

- > 1 State Championship
  - Only official Texas USAG Entry Form accepted (downloadable form posted on TXUSAG.com)

## Entry Fees

- \$120.00 Championship (\$5.00 per entry fee must be sent to Region 3 for the apparel fund).
- > Entry fees must be received by the date posted on the Competition Deadline Chart.
- > Entries received after the deadline may be accepted by the meet director on space availability with the approval of the competition committee
- Late fees will apply to the online registration as well as the payment/paper entry being received.
  - 30% of the total entry fee will be charged for late fees. The online reservation will be considered late and subject to the late fee, if not done by Midnight Monday after a qualifying meet or the deadline date.
- ➤ Entry Fee refunds will be given prior to the Entry deadline. Fees are non- refundable after the deadline. Please see the official competition deadline chart for specific dates.

#### Gate Fees

## > Districts & District Championships

•	Adults	\$ <mark>15</mark> per day
•	Children 12 & under/ Seniors 60+	\$ <mark>10</mark> per day

#### State

•	Adults	\$ <mark>15</mark> per day
•	Children 12 & under/ Seniors 60+	\$ <mark>10</mark> per day

## > If off-site facility is used

•	Adults	\$20 per day
•	Children 12 & under/ Seniors 60+	\$15 per day

### Judges

- Judges must hold a Level 8 or above rating.
- State Championships Two judges per panel plus a separate meet referee.
- ➤ The State Administrative Assignment Committee will determine the final selection of officials for the State Championships.
- > Athlete's individual event score and Start Values will be flashed at all optional competitions.

#### Event Awards

- Official USAG State Championship Medals are required at the State Championships. Order the Official USA Gymnastics State Championship medals through the State Chair.
- > Events: 50% of the athletes entered in each Age Group must be recognized with Medals on each of the four (4) individual events.
- > 100% of the athletes must be recognized in the All Around with medals.
- ➤ The Meet Host is financially responsible for the state medals.

### Team Competition

➤ <u>Large Team:</u> Clubs entering Team Competition with <u>11 or more athletes</u> will be placed into <u>Large Team</u> competition. 7 scores will count for Large Team Competition.

- ➤ <u>Medium Team</u>: Clubs entering Team Competition with <u>6-10 athletes</u> will be placed into <u>Medium Team</u> competition. 5 scores will count for Medium Team competition.
- ➤ <u>Small Team</u>: Clubs entering Team Competition with <u>3-5 athletes</u> will be placed into <u>Small Team</u> competition. 3 scores will count for Small Team competition.
- > Team size may NOT change after the entry deadline.
- > Team Competition will be allowed at the Texas State Championships.
- ➤ At State Championships (banners must be used): Teams will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>. \*\*\*No charge for team competition. All clubs will be entered in team competition based on the number of athletes registered. \*\*\*
- ➤ The official Banner supplier company is recommended for ALL State Program competitions but is not required as long as the banner supplier chosen meets state size, weight and quality requirements of the banner.

# Qualifying Procedures

## > State Championships

- By a score of 32.00 obtained at any USA Gymnastics Invitational held in Texas that is an approved qualifier.
- Event specialists 9.1 event score to qualify to State.
- Athlete may injury petition to State Championships with proof of a 32.00 from the prior season as a level 8.

# **Regional Championships**

➤ The qualifying score for Level 7 and 8 Regionals in 2024 is a 34.00 All Around at the State Meet. No IES. All around petitions will be considered.

## Special Rules

- ➤ Gymnast must have reached her 8<sup>th</sup> birthday to compete Level 8 (she may compete on her 8<sup>th</sup> birthday).
- Gymnast may drop back one level prior to state.
- ➤ A minimum score of 34.00 must be obtained to move to Level 9.

## > State Championships

- Age Groups for Level 8 State Championships will be as follows: Jr. A, Jr. B, Jr. C, Sr. A, Sr. B, Sr. C.
- In the event entry numbers are low, the number of age groups may be reduced with the approval of a competition chairperson.
- The ultimate goal is to have approximately 15 athletes per age group.
- Competitive Draw for sessions at state championships MUST be by Age Group.

### Regional Championships

- Athletes will be distributed into age groups set by RAC.
- Age is determined according to age the athlete will be at Regional Championships.
- The format and number of athletes must be approved by the Regional DP Committee Chairman and Regional Technical Committee Chairman.

## Event Specialist

- > Athletes must declare as a specialist prior to the State Championships.
- > 9.1 event score required to qualify to State Championships.
